

#### Field Notes 3.98 Acre Tract

A 3.98 acre tract of land was described as containing 4.0 acres in the Document 633966 recorded in the Official Records of Hidalgo County as being out of Tract No. 1 of the subdivision of the David Chapa Homestead Tract of 200.0 acres out of the southeast corner of Share 3, Schuniors Subdivision of Porciones 73, 74, and 75 Hidalgo County, Texas described in the deed recorded in Volume 784 at page 417 of the Deed Records of Hidalgo County Texas, Said 3.98 acre tract being more particularly described as follows, being oriented to the Texas Lambert Coordinate System; NAD 27:

Beginning at a 4 inch steel pipe found set for the southwest corner of this 3.98 acre tract on the east line of an irrigation canal right of way, from whence a fence corner found set on the north line of U.S. Highway 83 bears S 14° 18' 22" W for 818.62 feet, and N.G.S. Station "Pedro" bears S 78° 39' 14" W for 7876.43 feet;

Thence N 14° 18' 22" E for 263.59 feet with the east right of way of the said canal to a 4 inch steel post found set for a corner on this east right of way line at the beginning of a right of way curve to the right:


Thence following with the canal right of way with the curve on a radius of 1,105.0 feet through an arc of 10° 59' 06" for a distance of 211.85 feet to a 4 inch steel post found set for the northwest corner of this tract;

Thence S 81° 17' 26" E for 329.80 feet to a 4 inch steel post found set for the northeast corner of this tract;

Thence S 8° 55' 10" W for 469.29 feet to a 4 inch steel pipe found set for the southeast corner of this tract;

Thence N 81° 22' 21" W for 394.78 feet to the Point of Beginning enclosing 3.98 acres within this tract.


