GATHERING CHARGE: Where gathering service is performed by Carrier at the following gathering locations, a charge of **[I]** 97.99 cents per barrel will apply.

Good Gathering (including Borden and Dawson Counties)
Jo Mill Gathering, Borden County

HAND RUN GAUGING FEE: There will be an additional charge of **[I]** 42.05 cents per barrel on gathered Crude Petroleum which is hand run gauged.

TRUCK UNLOAD CHARGE: All shipments unloaded from tank truck facilities into the facilities of the Carrier will be subject to an additional charge as set forth below:

PUMPOVER CHARGE: A pumpover charge of **[I]** 14.07 cents per barrel of 42 U.S. gallons will apply to Crude Petroleum received into Carrier's terminal at Colorado City or China Grove, Scurry County, Texas and delivered to connecting carriers. The pumpover charge will not apply to Crude Petroleum received from NuStar Permian Transportation and Storage, LLC at Colorado City or China Grove, Scurry County, Texas and delivered to Plains Pipeline, L.P.'s Basin pipeline system at Colorado City or China Grove.

CAPITAL SURCHARGE: For Crude Petroleum gathered at Good Gathering-Jo Mill Meter 135 and Jo Mill Gathering-Jo Mill Meter 280, in addition to the rates noted above, effective January 1, 2019, a surcharge in the amount of **[U]** 15.0 cents per barrel will be assessed on Crude Petroleum for the purpose of amortizing certain capital expenditures associated with the pipeline. The initial capital expenditures to be amortized by the surcharge will be on all volumes received for four years.

EXCEPTIONS TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS TARIFF:

Item No. 10 – Application of Rates and Charges. In lieu of the provisions stated in Item No. 10 of the Rules and Regulations Tariff, trunkline transportation and all other lawful charges will be collected on the basis of net quantities of Petroleum received from the Shipper at origin.

Item No. 7 – The pipeline loss allowance of two-tenths of one percent specified in Item No. 7 of the Rules and Regulations Tariff will not apply to Crude Petroleum received by truck or from connecting carriers at Colorado City or China Grove, Scurry County.
