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Submitting Data to RRC with EDI

Electronic Data Interchange

Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) is a filing method where a data file, in a standard format, is submitted electronically to the RRC by the operator. Because EDI documents must be processed by computers, a standard format must be used so that the computer can read and understand the documents. A standard format defines and describes the required format (e.g., integer, decimal, mmddyy) of each piece of information in the data file.

The following types of data can be submitted as EDI files through [RRC Online](#):

- Annual Disposal/Injection Well Monitoring Report (H-10)
- Completion Reports
- Oil & Gas Well Status Reports (G-10/W-10)
- Pipeline Integrity forms (PS-81 and PS-95)
- Production Reports (PR)
- Texas Damage Reporting Form (TDRF)
- Natural Gas Tariffs

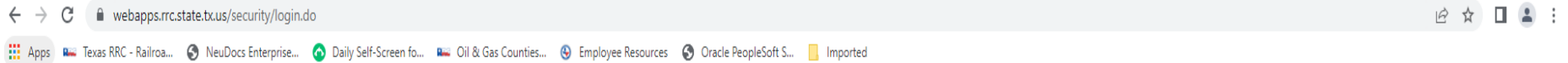

The RRC Online System allows authorized entities to electronically file certain forms with the Railroad Commission online or through EDI. Forms processed through this system are ones containing data that has been migrated from the Commission's mainframe to an open system environment. Through the RRC Online System, forms can be filed online over the Internet using a web browser, or data files can be uploaded through the application.

How to Obtain a User ID:

To utilize the Online Filing system, you must have a User ID that is assigned to you by your company's designated Security Administrator. A company or individual may designate a Security Administrator by completing the Security Administrator Designation (SAD) form and mailing it to the RRC. When the SAD form is processed, the Security Administrator will receive a User ID and a temporary initial password. The Security Administrator will be able to log into the RRC Online System using their assigned User ID and create User IDs for users within their company. They will also be able to assign certain electronic filing rights for those accounts, and perform account maintenance activities (such as resetting passwords) when needed.

If you are uncertain whether your company has a security administrator, please email the Commission at rrconline-security@rrc.texas.gov.

3. Complete and sign the form then mail it to the RRC, following instructions on Page 2 of the form. When the form is processed, the designated security administrator will receive a User ID and temporary password by email.
4. The security administrator will log into the system and assign User IDs and filing rights.

Computer Generated Hard-Copy Forms

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Guidelines for Filing Computer-Generated Hardcopy Forms

Approval Process for Computer-Generated Form Templates

The Railroad Commission of Texas (Commission) has the following guidelines for those who develop computer-generated form templates ("form templates"). Form templates must follow Commission specifications and be approved for use by the Commission Forms Coordinator. If you have questions about form templates, contact the Forms Coordinator at ogformscoordinator@rrc.texas.gov.

1. To request approval of a form template, email the Forms Coordinator at ogformscoordinator@rrc.texas.gov and attach two PDF versions of the form template: one blank version and one sample filled in with the letter z and the number 9. The form template must meet the required specifications discussed in the "Required Specifications for Form Templates" Section below.
2. Upon approval of a form template, the Forms Coordinator will assign the form template a unique approval identifier (UAI), which is a unique code consisting of letters and numbers. The UAI must be located directly under the form designation number (i.e., "Form W-15") and the creation/revision date.
3. Once a form template has been approved and assigned a UAI, any person may file the form template as long as the filed form is identical to the form that was submitted and approved. The UAI must appear on the approved form template every time the form is used for filing.
4. Occasionally, the Commission will replace, revise, or repeal its forms. If you wish to file a previously-approved form template after the Commission form has been replaced or revised, you must follow the approval guidelines to submit a new form template and receive a new UAI.
5. If the Commission repeals the Commission form that corresponds to the form template, the Commission will no longer accept the form template.

DISCLAIMER

Note: It is your responsibility to seek approval for a form template if the Commission form is replaced or revised. A form template that has not been approved, or is altered after approval and receipt of a UAI, will not be accepted by the Commission. Further, changes to these guidelines may make previously-approved form templates invalid. If you have questions about a form template and its eligibility for filing, please contact the Forms Coordinator at ogformscoordinator@rrc.texas.gov.

Further, under Texas Natural Resources Code Section 91.143 it is a felony to (1) make or subscribe any application, report, or other document required or permitted to be filed with the Commission knowing that the application, report, or other document is false or untrue in any material facts, or (2) knowingly simulate or falsely or fraudulently execute or sign such an application, report, or other document.
