# What is a Plan of Correction (POC)?



- Operator's response to alleged violations
  - Corrective action
  - Extension Request

### Submitting a Response



- Responses sent via email or mail
  - Email: <u>safety@rrc.texas.gov</u>
  - Mail:1701 North Congress Ave. P.O. Box 12967
    Austin, Texas 78711-2967
    - All correspondence must include Inspection Package number.

## POC Response Expectations



- Plan for corrective action
  - Detailed plan of action to be taken
  - Estimated completion date
- Requesting Extension
  - Provide reason for extension request
  - Reasonable date for completion

### Supporting Documentation



- Supporting documentation includes:
  - Pictures
  - Completed work orders
  - Highlighted changes to procedures
  - Training attendance roster
  - Training material

#### POC Approval / Completion



- POC is approved
  - Clear corrective action with dates
  - Supporting documentation
- POC is complete
  - All corrective actions completed
  - All supporting documentation submitted

#### **POC** Rejections



- A POC is rejected when:
  - Inadequate / no documentation provided
  - No specified completion date
  - Inadequate completion date
- New correspondence sent
  - Includes reason for rejection

#### **Delinquent POCs**



- How does a POC become delinquent?
  - No response received from operator
    - 40 days after initial letter
    - 10 days after estimated completion date
- Follow-up inspections
  - One year after initial correspondence.

#### Avoiding Delinquent Status



- Executive Closing Summary
  - Sent at the end of every inspection
  - Includes alleged violations
- Official letter not received
  - Contact inspector
  - Verify mailing and email address
