Summary

The RRC proposes the amendments to implement House Bill 4042, 89th Texas Legislature (Regular Session, 2025). The bill removes the specification that gas must be natural gas with respect to pipelines and distribution systems, thereby extending the Commission’s regulatory fee authority to include propane (LP-gas).
