

All that certain tract or parcel containing 1.063 acres of land in Hidalgo County, Texas, being a portion of Lot 1 and Lot 7, Block One of Trenton Town Center, a subdivision of record in Volume 49, Page 117, of the of the Hidalgo County Map Records (HCMR), said 1.063 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, basing coordinates and bearings upon the Texas Coordinate System of 1983 (1996 Adjustment), South Zone, to wit:

BEGINNING at a 5/8" iron rod set for north corner of said Lot 1, northwest corner of said Lot 7, southwest corner of a tract which was called 0.82 acre and conveyed from Juan Montemayor, et ux, to Mo-Vac Service Company, by an instrument of record in Volume 1722, Page 249, of the Hidalgo County Deed Records (HCDR), lying in the southeast right of way (R-O-W) line of Southern Pacific Railroad;

THENCE S 81°20'30" E, 143.75 feet along the common line of said Lot 7 and said 0.82 acre tract to a point for northeast corner, lying in the west line of a "AEPTCC" 100' easement as delineated in Clerks Document #1506525, of the Hidalgo County Official Public Records (HCOPR);

THENCE S 08°40'00" W, 200.00 feet crossing said Lot 7, along the west line of said 100' wide easement to a point for southeast corner;

THENCE N 81°20'30" W, 319.21 feet crossing said Lot 7 and said Lot 1 to a point for southwest corner, lying in the northwest line of said Lot 1 and southeast line of the aforementioned Southern Pacific Railroad R-O-W;

THENCE N 49°55'23" E, along the northwest line of Lot 1 and southeast line of said Southern Pacific Railroad R-O-W, at 169.82 feet pass a 1/2" iron rod found, and continuing for a distance in all of 266.07 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, and containing 1.063 acres of land, more or less. A certified plat has been prepared under the same job number as a part of this professional service.





Representatives of Wal-Mart Stores Texas, LLC have completed response actions pursuant to Chapter 91, Subchapter O, Texas Natural Resource Code, at the tract of land described in Exhibit "A" to this certificate that pertains to a 1.063 acre tract in Edinburg, Hidalgo County, VCP No. 04-60003 located in Hidalgo County, Texas. The Site was owned by Wal-Mart Stores Texas, L.P., at the time the application to participate in the Voluntary Cleanup Program was filed. The Applicant has submitted and received approval from the Railroad Commission of Texas Voluntary Cleanup Program on all plans and reports required by the Voluntary Cleanup Agreement. The plans and reports were prepared using a prudent degree of inquiry of the Site, consistent with accepted industry standards to identify all contaminants, waste, and contaminated media of regulatory concern. The response actions for the site have achieved response action levels acceptable for unrestricted residential use with no reliance on institutional or physical controls as determined by the standards of the RRC.
